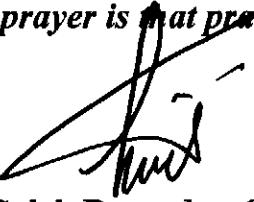

The University of Gharyan is one of the prestigious higher education institutions in Libya and represents an important scientific and developmental pillar in the Western Mountain region. Its academic beginnings date back to 1985, when the Faculty of Accounting was established in the city of Gharyan, which at that time was one of the faculties affiliated with the University of Tripoli, forming the first nucleus of formal university education in the city.

With the growing societal demand for higher education and the increasing need for qualified national cadres, Gharyan witnessed a gradual expansion in the establishment of Faculties and higher institutes during the subsequent years, which initially operated under the name "University of Departments in Gharyan," in an experiment aimed at providing university education opportunities for the region's youth and bringing educational institutions closer to the local community.

In a later stage, specifically within the policies of developing higher education and unifying administrative structures, the name "Western Mountain University" was adopted to reflect the geographical extension and regional role of the university in serving the cities and areas of the Western Mountain, whether through academic programs or research and community activities.

In 2009, and within comprehensive organizational decisions, the university was merged with the Seventh of April University in the city of Zawiya, as part of a national trend aimed at enhancing integration between higher education institutions and improving the efficiency of academic and financial administration. This stage continued until the issuance of the decision to reorganize and structure Libyan universities in 2018, which restored institutional independence to a number of universities, and the name "University of Gharyan" was officially adopted, thus beginning a new phase of construction and development.

Since its re-establishment as an independent university, the University of Gharyan has experienced a qualitative shift in its academic and institutional journey, represented by horizontal and vertical expansion in the establishment of Faculties and specializations, updating academic regulations, and enhancing educational and service infrastructure. The number of university Faculties has increased to reach twenty faculties distributed across a number of cities and

regions, covering diverse specializations that include medical and health sciences, engineering and technological sciences, applied sciences, humanities and social sciences, and administrative and economic sciences, meeting the needs of the labor market and the requirements of local and national development.

The University pays special attention to the quality of the educational process through developing study plans, adopting modern teaching methods, activating practical and applied education, in addition to supporting scientific research, encouraging academic publication, and building scientific partnerships with universities and research institutions inside and outside Libya.

The University of Gharyan also plays an effective role in serving the community and developing the environment through training programs, scientific consultations, awareness initiatives, and participation in addressing societal issues, stemming from its national responsibility and as an educational institution emanating from the community and committed to its values and principles.

Within the framework of its future vision, the University seeks to achieve quality standards and institutional and programmatic accreditation, develop university governance and management systems, and enhance digital transformation, contributing to raising the level of academic and administrative performance and achieving excellence and sustainability.

The University of Gharyan believes that higher education is the cornerstone in building human beings and developing society, and continuously strives to prepare scientifically and professionally qualified graduates who possess competence, skill, and moral commitment, and are able to effectively contribute to the journey of development and building the nation.

## **Strategic Identity**

The five-year strategic plan for the University of Gharyan (2022-2027) was launched based on the decision issued by the University President No. (166) of 2021, which mandated the formation of a specialized team to prepare the university's strategic plan, within the framework of the university's efforts to establish institutional strategic planning, enhance governance, and achieve sustainable development. The plan was prepared using a scientific, participatory methodology that went through three main, interconnected stages, as follows:

### ***First: Preparation and Planning Stage***

This stage focused on building the general framework of the plan by reviewing official documents and regulations governing higher education, analyzing previous plans, and conducting benchmarking comparisons with several local, regional, and international universities to benefit from best practices in education, scientific research, community service, and university administration.

### ***Second: Plan Preparation and Formulation Stage***

This stage involved organizing workshops and consultative meetings in which academic and administrative leaders, representatives of faculty members, employees, and students participated, contributing to the formulation of the university's vision, mission, and institutional values. Internal and external strategic analysis models for the university environment (SWOT) were completed, along with stakeholder analysis, identification of strategic issues, and formulation of strategic objectives, initiatives, and performance indicators, leading to the preparation of the final document of the strategic plan in its approved format.

### ***Third: Implementation, Follow-up, and Evaluation Stage***

This stage focuses on transforming strategic objectives into operational plans and executive programs, identifying responsibilities and timelines, and adopting performance measurement indicators, in addition to activating mechanisms for periodic follow-up and evaluation, ensuring measurement of progress, addressing challenges, and achieving continuous improvement in accordance with quality and institutional accreditation requirements.

The strategic plan of the University of Gharyan embodies its institutional identity and reflects its commitment to developing academic and administrative performance, enhancing scientific research, and activating its role in serving society, in line with national and international changes, contributing to the achievement of sustainable development.

The strategic plan is based on the following vision, mission, and objectives:

### **Vision**

To be a leading institution in higher education and community service, distinguished internationally for the quality of its scientific outputs and its capacity for innovation and sustainable development.

### **Mission**

To offer innovative educational programs that keep pace with the requirements of the modern era and align with quality in higher education, helping to prepare distinguished graduates who possess knowledge and skills in all humanities and applied sciences, meeting the needs of society and achieving the development and advancement of various societal institutions.

### **Objectives**

- 1) To prepare qualified and creative cadres capable of self-learning and innovation, keeping pace with the requirements of sustainable development.
- 2) To supply the labor market with specialized competencies in various fields, in line with the state's policy for human resource development.
- 3) To develop the educational process at both the university education and postgraduate studies levels according to the latest educational methods.
- 4) To conduct applied and theoretical research and studies which contribute to solving social and economic problems and serving society.

- 5) To link research activity with development plans and future visions of society.
- 6) To enhance community service through continuous interaction with its economic, social, and cultural institutions, and to provide scientific and technical consultations.
- 7) To develop human resources and improve their efficiency through continuing education and training programs, and to disseminate scientific and humanistic culture.
- 8) To expand horizons of scientific cooperation with universities and educational institutions locally and internationally, and to exchange experiences and academic programs.
- 9) To open up to global experiences and expertise in thought, science, and culture.
- 10) To update teaching programs, develop academic quality standards, and encourage student activities.
- 11) To qualify faculty members and develop their skills, and provide necessary incentives to enhance their academic and research performance.
- 12) To enhance scientific research and research training by developing research plans and programs.
- 13) To support cooperation with specialized international bodies to exchange expertise and open up to global developments.

Education and Learning are the central focus of the academic process at the University of Gharyan. The university strives to provide a quality educational environment that integrates theoretical knowledge with practical application,

ensuring the preparation of graduates who are scientifically and professionally qualified, capable of meeting the demands of the job market and serving the community. This approach is implemented through the development of academic programs, the support of student activities, a focus on educational infrastructure such as laboratories, and the enhancement of graduate studies programs.

The university is home to both Libyan and international students of various nationalities, including both current students and graduates, as presented in Tables 1 through 7 , reflecting its role in accommodating a wide spectrum of learners and offering higher education opportunities on a structured academic basis. The university is also keen on monitoring the status of new students, continuing students, and graduates, ensuring the smooth operation of the educational process and the achievement of effective learning outcomes.

Scientific research is considered one of the fundamental pillars upon which the mission of the University of Gharyan is based, as it is a higher education institution that seeks to produce knowledge, localize it, and employ it in serving society and national development. Based on this role, the university has given increasing attention to scientific research in its various theoretical and applied fields, making it an essential element in its strategic plans alongside the educational process and community service.

The University of Gharyan, through its various scientific, medical, engineering, humanities, and applied Faculties, works to support and encourage scientific research among faculty members, researchers, and graduate students by adopting stimulating policies and providing an academic environment that supports creativity and innovation. These efforts contribute to directing research toward addressing priority societal and development issues, which enhances the university's connection with its local and national surroundings.

In terms of organizing and publishing scientific output, the university is keen to issue peer-reviewed scientific journals concerned with publishing original research in accordance with approved scientific standards, ensuring content quality, methodological soundness, and transparent peer review. These journals represent an important scientific platform to highlight researchers' contributions and enhance the university's academic presence at both local and international levels.

The scientific research activity at the university also includes research published in scientific journals and conferences inside and outside Libya, which reflects the level of scientific competence of faculty members and contributes to raising the university's ranking and enhancing its academic reputation. This research varies between basic and applied studies, serving different scientific and humanities specializations.

In addition to scientific publishing, the University of Gharyan pays special attention to organizing workshops, seminars, and training courses of a research and scientific nature, which aim to develop research skills and enhance researchers' capabilities in research methodology, scientific analysis, academic publishing, and research ethics. These scientific activities represent a fundamental resource for building an aware academic community capable of keeping pace with modern scientific developments.

Accordingly, scientific research at the University of Gharyan forms an integrated system that seeks to achieve quality and excellence, linking theoretical knowledge with practical application, which enhances the university's role as an effective and influential scientific center in the path of sustainable development.

Based on the importance of organizing and documenting research work in a methodical manner, this report will address the aspects of scientific research at the University of Gharyan in detail, with each aspect having a separate section that deals with its content individually. This includes a separate presentation of scientific research, scientific journals issued by the university, published research, in addition to workshops, seminars, and training courses, with an explanation of the role of each aspect in supporting the research process, and an analysis of its contributions to developing academic performance and enhancing the quality of scientific outputs at the university and its various Faculties.

### **First: Scientific Journals**

Within the framework of the University of Gharyan's commitment to the policies of the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research, and its keenness to align its academic and research programs with the targets of the National Strategic Plan for Higher Education Development, the university gives scientific

research a central position as one of the basic pillars for developing the university education system, enhancing its quality, and raising its educational and research outputs. The university pursues this approach based on its deep understanding of the importance of scientific research in producing knowledge, supporting innovation, and contributing to finding scientific and practical solutions to the development challenges facing society, in addition to its vital role in enhancing the competitiveness of universities and raising their academic ranking at both local and international levels.

During the period covered by this report, the University of Gharyan has sought to build and strengthen an integrated scientific research system based on providing a stimulating and supportive research environment, and enabling faculty members and researchers to perform their research role efficiently and effectively. This included working on developing policies and procedures regulating scientific research, encouraging individual and group research work, and supporting research initiatives that align with national development priorities and the needs of the local community, which contributes to strengthening the relationship between the university and society, and establishing the university's role as a knowledge-producing institution and a fundamental resource for sustainable development.

The university also paid special attention to developing the research capabilities of faculty members and researchers by encouraging participation in various scientific activities, supporting scientific publication in peer-reviewed and accredited scientific journals and periodicals, and adhering to the ethics of scientific research and academic quality standards. These efforts aim to raise the level of scientific output, improve the quality of research outputs, and increase publication rates in journals with accredited classification, which positively reflects on the academic reputation of the university and enhances its scientific presence regionally and internationally.

In this context, the University of Gharyan publishes six peer-reviewed scientific journals, which represent one of the main tools for supporting the system of scientific research and academic publishing at the university. These journals are concerned with publishing high-quality original research, specialized studies, and scientific reviews in various scientific and humanities fields, in both Arabic and

English, which provides broader opportunities for exchanging scientific knowledge and enhancing research communication between researchers from inside and outside the university. These journals strictly adhere to approved academic publishing standards, requiring the originality of the scientific works submitted for publication, that they have not been previously published or submitted to any other entity, in addition to subjecting them to precise and transparent scientific peer review procedures that ensure the quality of scientific content, objectivity of evaluation, and credibility of research results.

The scientific journals issued by the University of Gharyan have contributed to providing reliable scientific platforms for publishing the scientific output of faculty members and researchers, supporting research activity within Faculties and research centers, and promoting a culture of scientific research and sound academic publishing. These journals have also played a prominent role in enhancing the university's academic presence, establishing its position as an effective educational and research institution at both local and international levels, in addition to their contribution to achieving quality and institutional accreditation targets by adhering to academic excellence standards and controlling the quality of research outputs.

Despite the challenges facing the scientific research system, especially the limited financial resources and support allocated to research activities, the University of Gharyan continues its efforts to enhance and develop scientific research through the proper utilization of available resources, encouraging research partnerships and academic cooperation with universities and research institutions inside and outside Libya, and benefiting from the scientific expertise available among its academic staff.

In this context, the university affirms that enhancing support for scientific research is one of its strategic priorities for the next stage, due to its direct impact on developing academic performance, improving the quality of university education, and enhancing the university's ability to effectively contribute to serving society and achieving comprehensive development goals. The university concludes this section by affirming its firm commitment to continue supporting scientific research and academic publishing, and working on developing its mechanisms and tools, in a way that ensures the sustainability of research activity,

raises the level of scientific outputs, and enhances the position of the University of Gharyan as a leading academic and research institution that effectively contributes to building a knowledge economy and keeps pace with rapid scientific and technological developments.

## Fifth: Training

The University of Gharyan pays special attention to the field of training and capacity development, considering it a fundamental pillar that supports the educational process and institutional development, and an effective tool for enhancing the efficiency of faculty members, administrative staff, and technical personnel. This contributes to improving academic and administrative performance and enhancing the quality of education and learning. The Training and Development Center at the University of Gharyan is the cornerstone for advancing human resources within the university, as it aims to bridge skill gaps and update knowledge to keep pace with scientific and technological developments, and enhances the ability to apply best practices in university work.

In this context, the Center plays a pivotal role in planning, implementing, and following up on training activities by preparing annual training plans stemming from the needs of the Faculties and departments, organizing specialized courses and workshops, and building training partnerships with educational and professional institutions inside and outside the university. It also works on

consolidating a culture of continuous learning, developing human competencies, and enhancing institutional capacities, in line with the university's directions and the requirements for quality and academic accreditation.

### **Objectives of the Center:**

- ♦ To enhance the efficiency of the academic staff in the fields of scientific research and modern educational technologies,
- ♦ To develop the administrative and technical skills of employees to ensure the quality of institutional performance,
- ♦ To keep pace with the technological boom by integrating artificial intelligence tools into university work,
- ♦ To enhance the personal and leadership skills of university affiliates.

The training programs for the year 2025 diversified to include four main tracks:

1. **The Technical and Artificial Intelligence Track:** Included courses on generative AI, text processing, and email management.
2. **The Research and Statistical Track:** Focused on the SPSS program for statistical analysis.
3. **The Administrative Track:** Included a course on preparing administrative correspondence and reports.
4. **The Personal Track:** A personal skills development course.

The University of Gharyan is committed to enhancing its community and environmental role, considering it as one of the cornerstones of its educational and developmental mission. The University of Gharyan pays great attention to the quality of the educational process, considering it the cornerstone of higher education development and a guarantee for distinguished academic outcomes. The university focuses on applying national and international quality standards across all its academic programs to ensure the efficiency of education and the effectiveness of learning, and to enhance the scientific and professional capabilities of its graduates.

The path of educational quality at the university begins with Institutional Accreditation, which reflects the university's commitment to regulatory and administrative standards. This includes the evaluation of the administrative structure, human resources, infrastructure, and teaching and learning policies to ensure the provision of an integrated and reliable educational environment. This is followed by Programmatic Accreditation, which pertains to each Faculty and educational program individually. It aims to evaluate the quality of curricula, teaching methods, assessment tools, and learning outcomes, reflecting the extent of each program's commitment to accredited academic standards.

The efforts of accreditation are complemented by the qualitative activities carried out by the university's Quality Administration and the quality departments in the faculties. These include workshops, seminars, monitoring academic performance, and analyzing learning indicators, all to enhance a culture of quality within the university and support the development of the educational process in line with best global practices.

The following is an overview of the university's efforts in institutional and programmatic accreditation, alongside the activities carried out by the Quality Administration and its Faculty departments to enhance the quality of teaching and learning.

**First: Institutional Accreditation:** In recent years, the University of Gharyan has worked on completing the requirements for institutional accreditation through:

- Developing organizational structures and internal regulations.
- Activating quality assurance and accreditation systems.

- Documenting academic and administrative procedures.
- Preparing self-study reports in accordance with the models approved by the National Center for Quality Assurance and Accreditation of Educational Institutions.

These efforts have contributed to raising the university's institutional readiness and preparing it to meet accreditation standards, which reflects its commitment to improving institutional performance and achieving academic sustainability.

**Second: Programmatic Accreditation:** In parallel with institutional accreditation, the university has given special attention to programmatic accreditation at the level of Faculties and academic programs. A number of Faculties have begun to:

- Review and update study plans.
- Align learning outcomes with labor market requirements.
- Document course and program files.
- Complete the requirements for on-site visits and external evaluation.

The path of institutional and programmatic accreditation at the University of Gharyan reflects a clear direction towards establishing the principles of quality and academic governance. It confirms the university's continuous pursuit of elevating the level of higher education, achieving competitiveness, and enhancing its standing among higher education institutions at both the national and regional levels.

Two of the university's Faculties, the Faculty of Science in Gharyan and the Faculty of Arts in Al-Asha'abah, have succeeded in obtaining institutional accreditation after meeting the required standards. This is a result of joint efforts between the university's Quality Administration, faculty members, administrative staff, and the quality departments in those Faculties, reflecting a high level of academic commitment and the university's keenness to ensure the quality of its educational programs.

These Faculties will submit their files for programmatic accreditation and are currently at different stages of evaluation and review procedures, whether at the

self-study level or during evaluation visits, as part of a phased plan approved by the university administration.

Other Faculties are currently working on completing the quality standards requirements, in preparation for applying for institutional accreditation in the near future. This is part of a comprehensive vision aimed at generalizing the culture of quality and ensuring accreditation across all university Faculties and programs.
